AAIA Board Volunteers. These are experienced volunteers from across Canada who assume responsibility for our mission, our personnel and our finances.

AAIA Community Volunteers. People interested in allergy, asthma or anaphylaxis who work in their communities on an on-going basis by networking, organizing support groups, making presentations, and much more. They receive special training and are good mentors for new volunteers.

AAIA General Volunteers. Friends and members of the AAIA who, regularly or occasionally, lend a hand to a variety of tasks and duties (mailings, special events, etc.) individually or as part of a team.

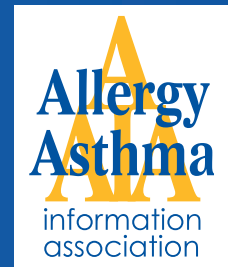
